AN EXECUTIVE ORDER IMPOSING GARBAGE SEGREGATION FROM SOURCE AND SEGRAGATED GARBAGE COLLECTION IN COMPLIANCE TO REPUBLIC ACT 9003 OR THE "ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT ACT OF 2000" IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TUNGA, LEYTE

WHEREAS, in reference to Republic Act 9003 or the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 and Municipal Ordinance No. 01 – 2011, entitled, "An Ordinance Implementing the Municipal Comprehensive Solid Waste Management of the Municipality of Tunga, Leyte, Prescribing Guidelines for its implementations, Imposing Penalties and Sanctions for the Violation thereof";

WHEREAS, as mandated by R.A. 7160, Title Two, Chapter 3, Section 444, Paragraph b (2) (iii) which stipulates that the Local Chief Executive shall, "Issue such executive orders as are necessary for the proper enforcement and execution of laws and ordinances";

WHEREAS, this executive order aims to strictly impose the garbage segregation from source and segregated garbage collection within the Municipality of Tunga and its immediate vicinity.

WHEREAS, the following guidelines shall be followed in addition to the existing statute and ordinance;


- i. Garbage segregation shall be strictly imposed and enforced in the Municipality of Tunga and its immediate vicinity;
- ii. All households, institutions and businesses are strictly directed to segregate Compostable, Recyclable, Residual and Special Waste;
- iii. There shall be a separate container for each type of waste from all sources, the containers shall be properly marked or identified as "Compostable/Bio-degradable", "Recyclable", "Residual", and "Special Waste" or any other classification as may be determined by the commission;

- iv. The Barangays shall be responsible in the collection of recyclable and bio-degradable waste according to their respected schedule of collection;
- v. Only residual and special waste (to include hazardous waste) shall be collected by LGU – Tunga from Brgy. San Antonio, Sto. Niño, San Roque, San Vicente, San Pedro and Balire every Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Brgy. Astoga and Banawang every Tuesday and Thursday;
- vi. All Barangays shall create a Barangay Solid Waste Management Committee as stipulated in RA 9003 and will be tasked on installing Barangay MRF effective immediately after the approval of this Executive Order;
- vii. All Barangays shall adopt or create barangay ordinance addressing the Solid Waste Management issue at the soonest possible time.

WHEREAS, failure to comply with this Executive Order shall be dealt accordingly in consonance with the Penal Provisions of the existing Municipal Ordinance and Republic Act 9003.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CATALINA F. AGDA, Mayor of the Municipality of Tunga, Leyte by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me by law, do hereby order this Executive Order be in effect on 14 June 2021.
